TYPES OF CARE AVAILABLE

Retirement Living

Retirement living is perfect for those who would like to continue living independently but enjoy the peace of mind, security and companionship that retirement living offers. Our retirement living options include both Occupation Right Agreement and rental units.

Rest Homes

Our rest homes offer support for those who require extra assistance in their daily life as they grow older. Our team of dedicated staff are there to offer practical care and support while enabling residents to maintain independence, and continue living a fulfilling life through new friendships and activities.

Hospitals

Hospital-level care is provided by well-trained and experienced nursing staff. The care and support received in a hospital environment is for those who have a significant disability or medical concern and require the 24 hour support of a registered nurse.

Short and Long Term Care

Enliven provides both short and long term stays, depending on the need of the resident and family/whānau. Short term stay is for those who need to recover from illness before returning to their home or to give a carer a period of respite. Long term stay is for those who require full time medical and nursing care.

Dementia Care

We offer purpose-built dementia care in a safe and secure environment. We understand that older people with dementia require advanced care and support. Our team know how important family involvement is and will work with loved ones to ensure the needs and wishes of the family are also met. Dementia care is provided at rest home and hospital level in Peacehaven Village and at rest home level in Resthaven Village.

Respite Care and Carer Support

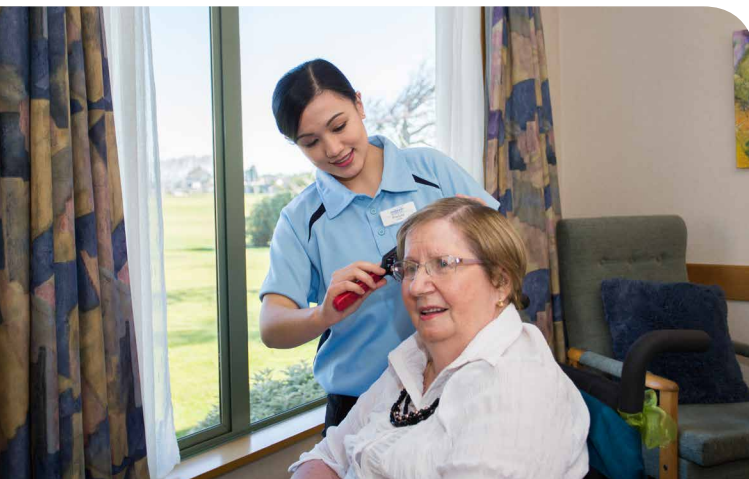
Looking after your loved one either in your home or theirs can be hard on the carer. The health and wellbeing of the carer is just as important, and regular short breaks enable the carer to feel refreshed. To ensure this happens, our residential aged care services offer both respite care and carer support at rest home and hospital level care.

Palliative Care

Enliven's highly regarded palliative care focuses on comfort and quality of life and includes promoting physical, emotional and spiritual wellbeing. Palliative care can be the sole focus of care, or it can be provided alongside some more active (life-prolonging) treatments. In this way we aim to support residents and their family/whānau to make the most of their time.

Our staff are trained in providing a high standard of palliative care, which includes management of pain and other symptoms, supporting the resident and their family/whānau to understand and adapt to changing health, and putting plans in place that allow a smooth transition to the end of life when that time comes.

Where options are noted, they apply to that site and are subject to availability.

Resthaven offers one and two bedroom units for independent living residents, as well as continuum of care should it be needed and available.

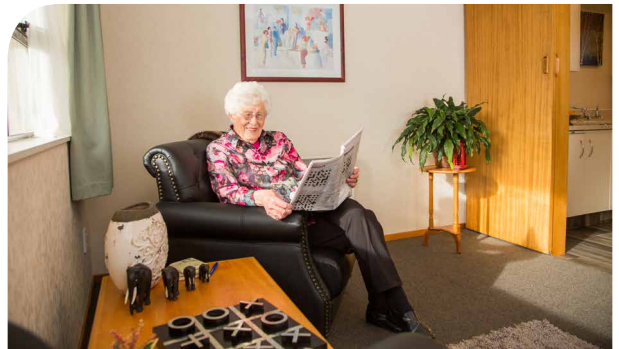
