



New Townhouse Interior Fit Out Details

Architecturally-designed, with meticulous attention to detail, our new villas offer retirement living with a touch of panache. Nestled in the heart of our existing village, our new villas take their lead from the terracotta brick cladding and dark coloursteel, gabled rooflines of the existing village, interpreted with a contemporary spin. With a mix of brick, timber and plaster cladding, contrasting coloursteel roofing and powder-coated double glazing, large windows, and a north-facing covered deck which can be closed in to make a conservatory and extend your living space, these villas not only make a statement but have been created to be comfortable for years to come.

We recognise Southland light and warmth are important. With open-plan, north-facing living, heat pump heating and a warm neutral interior colour scheme, your home will look and feel warm and be the perfect backdrop for your furnishings and accessories.

With your future needs in mind, our Premium duplex villas have a main bathroom which connects to both the master bedroom and the hallway and a second standalone half bathroom for guests. While our Premium Plus standalone villas have a private en-suite bathroom off the master bedroom and large wardrobes and a second full bathroom which connects to the second bedroom and the hallway for guests.

Choice is important, and you have several different floor plans to choose from. Some of our Premium villas also offer the option of a flexi space adjacent to the living area which can be used as an extension of your living space, a movie room, an office or as a second bedroom. The choice is yours.



If you decide village life isn't quite right within your first 90 days, you can cancel your agreement and have your capital payment returned (T&Cs apply).

No ongoing fees after departure*

All weekly fees stop once your contract ends and you've permanently vacated the village – no unexpected costs.

Flexibility to move*

Want to relocate within the village? You're welcome to transfer to another home, with some transfer fees applying.

Smooth transition to care*

Should your needs change, the Peacehaven care facility offers all levels of care on site, however, you also have the choice to request a move to any of the other facilities we own and operate. (Subject to room availability and completed needs assessment).

The purchase process made simple

Step one	Select the unit you'd like to live in
Step two	You will be provided with an application form to complete. Additionally, you may be asked to provide a medical report from your GP.
Step three	Return the completed application form – and medical report if requested – to the village for review and approval.
Step four	Once your application is approved, it will be sent to our solicitors, who will prepare the full ORA and forward the relevant documents to your solicitor.
Step five	We will supply you with the details needed to make your security deposit.
Step six	You will need to arrange a meeting with your solicitor, who will review the village's Disclosure Statement, ORA, Code of Residents' Rights, and Code of Practice documents with you. Once you and your solicitor are satisfied, both of you will sign the documents. The signed copies will then be returned to our solicitors for final signing by our team.
Step seven	Your security deposit should be paid to Covenant Trustee Services Ltd, the village's statutory supervisor, who will hold it in trust until the sale is finalised.
Step eight	Once the agreement is signed, a 15-day cooling-off period starts. During this time, you can change your mind and cancel the agreement. If you do cancel, you'll receive a full refund of any deposit you've paid.
Step nine	Your solicitor will transfer the final settlement amount to Covenant Trustee Services Ltd, who will hold these funds—along with the original deposit already in their care—until settlement is complete.
Step ten	Once settlement is completed you will be given the key to your new home by our village team who will be on hand to welcome you to our village and help you settle in. Our team will also spend some time with you to get you orientated and answer any questions you may have about the village rules and village life.

The care homes offer short and long-term care in rest home and hospital level, dementia, palliative and respite care.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is a retirement village?

A retirement village is a vibrant community of like-minded individuals who share similar interests, life experiences, and a desire for a fulfilling, carefree lifestyle. Residents enjoy the freedom to live independently while embracing the convenience of having everyday tasks — like home and garden maintenance — expertly managed by the village team. It's a place where community, connection, and peace of mind come together to create an enjoyable and enriching way of life.

What is an Occupation Right Agreement?

The Occupation Right Agreement (ORA) is the agreement signed between you and us which gives you the right to occupy your villa and enjoy all the amenities and services the village has to offer. While we retain ownership of the land, the ORA ensures your long-term comfort, security, and peace of mind in your new home.

What is the Disclosure Statement?

The Disclosure Statement is designed to give you a clear and comprehensive overview of the village—how it's owned, managed, and operated—so you can feel fully informed and confident in your decision. It also outlines the wide range of services available to you, along with details about costs, fees, and your financial return should you choose to move on. To support your peace of mind, we ensure you receive a copy of the Disclosure Statement well before signing your ORA, so everything is transparent from the start.

Can my family trust purchase an Occupation Right Agreement?

The Occupation Right Agreement (ORA) must to be held in the name(s) of the resident(s) who will be living in the village, ensuring all rights and services are directly connected to those enjoying the home, meaning a family trust can not purchase an ORA.

Can I rent all or part of my residential unit to someone else?

The residential unit is reserved exclusively for the resident(s) named in the Occupation Right Agreement (ORA), helping to maintain the safety, privacy, and sense of community that make village life so enjoyable. While renting out the unit isn't permitted, your family and friends are always welcome to visit and enjoy your new home with you.

Can I bequest my Occupation Right Agreement?

The Occupation Right Agreement (ORA) is designed to support you throughout your time in the village and is not transferable. It concludes when you (or your surviving spouse or partner) permanently leave the village or pass away. While the ORA itself can't be bequeathed, your estate will receive any financial return owed under the terms of the agreement, helping to provide peace of mind for you and your loved ones.

Can guests stay with me?

Yes, absolutely! Family and friends are warmly welcome to stay with you and share in your village lifestyle. Guests can stay for up to four weeks within a 12-month period, and if you ever need a longer visit, we're happy to consider it—just reach out for prior written approval. We're here to help make special moments with your loved ones as easy and enjoyable as possible.

Are there any restrictions to entry?

The village is designed for individuals aged 70 and over who are looking to enjoy an independent and active lifestyle. You (and your partner) should be in good health and able to live independently.

Where can I park my car(s)?

Most homes in the village (except those in the standard villas*) include a convenient single internal-access garage. Additional parking within the village is available for visitors, guests, and essential service providers. If you have a second vehicle, caravan, motorhome, or boat, we recommend arranging offsite parking to help keep the village safe and accessible for everyone.

Are there other village rules I need to know about?

Yes, our village rules are in place to help ensure everyone enjoys a safe, respectful, and peaceful environment. They set out clear and reasonable expectations to support the health, wellbeing, and quiet enjoyment of all residents, while fostering a strong sense of community. From time to time, these rules may be updated to reflect the evolving needs of the village.

Do I have to market my unit?

No, you won't need to worry about that. Once you end your ORA and leave your unit, we'll take care of the refurbishment and all aspects of marketing your home. We'll also share the marketing plan with you and keep you regularly updated on the progress of the sale.

What other costs will I have?

Alongside your weekly fees, you'll simply continue to cover your usual day-to-day living expenses—just like you would in any home. These may include things like groceries, utilities (such as power if separately metered), phone and internet plans, satellite TV, contents and car insurance, medical costs, and any personal care services you choose to use.
